






U.S. Gross Domestic Product







Annual Job Change - Washington MSA





Employment Composition by Sector July 2018 Washington MSA







Month Over the Year Change






Job Change by Sector July 2017 – July 2018 Washington MSA










Annual Job Change – Northern VA




Job Change by Sector July 2017 –July 2018 Northern Virginia



















Closed Sales and Inventory Fairfax County








Closed Sales and Inventory Arlington







Median Sales Price Forecast










Sales Forecast (units) Fairfax











Median Sales Price Forecast Arlington








Sales Forecast (units) Arlington








Inventory Forecast (months end) Arlington






